Frame Story

In 2016, Scientists on earth detected a fast radio burst from a distant region of space with no observable stars. This signal contained a constant series of data packets and a decryption key. These are those stories.

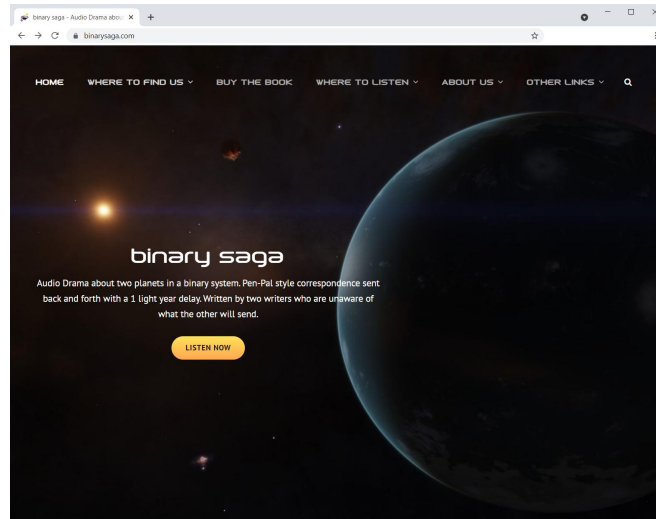
The Project
